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## United in Achievement

At Columbus Collegiate Academy (CCA), we measure proficiency longitudinally in terms of annual progress on Ohio state tests and interim progress during the school year on the i-Ready assessment in reading and math.

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## Measure 1: Ohio State Testing

The Ohio state tests are administered annually to measure student proficiency on state-mandated academic standards for each grade level. The state tests allow CCA to compare their results with Columbus City School District (CCSD) as well as schools across Ohio.

### *District and State Comparison*

The Ohio State Tests were administered in the spring of 2023. Below are the proficiency rates for each tested grade and subject.

	6th Grade	7th Grade	8th Grade
Reading	23.8%	37.5%	46.9%
Math	19.0%	20.8%	18.4%

CCA had higher proficiency rates than the comparison district 7th-grade math, 8th-grade reading, and 8th-grade science. CCA had lower proficiency rates than the state of Ohio average in every tested subject.

## Similar School Comparison

In order to consider our academic progress in context, CCA evaluated its rank by performance index compared to the Columbus City district schools students could attend if not enrolled at CCA. Each school in the table below has an economic disadvantage rate of 100%.

## Measure 2: i-Ready

CCA students take the i-Ready diagnostic assessment in the fall, winter, and spring each school year. The i-Ready assessments are state-aligned, computer-adaptive tests that accurately reflect the instructional level of each student and measure growth over time.

The assessment itself is unique in that it adapts to the student's ability, accurately measuring what a child knows and needs to learn. The diagnostic assessment pinpoints students' needs in reading and math down to the domain and sub-skill level by using sophisticated adaptive logic, and a bank of thousands of test items. Millions of test records have been collected over the last several years which allows us to compare our students' scores and growth with those of 6th, 7th, and 8th graders across the United States.

### *Grade Report*

This table shows the percentage of students who met their annual growth targets.

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## Program Profile

Columbus Collegiate Academy provides a college-preparatory, middle-grades education to students in Columbus, Ohio. Columbus Collegiate Academy delivers academic and character development programming that prepares students to gain entry and succeed in the most demanding high schools and colleges. Critical to meeting the CCA mission are the following program elements:

- An intensive curriculum with a strong focus on skill development, especially in reading, writing, science, social studies, and mathematics.
- A highly-structured environment that encourages and rewards positive decisions and offers immediate feedback and coaching when less-desirable decisions are made.
- Extended class time in literacy and mathematics (6th grade) to ensure proficiency in basic skills for all students.
- Regular homework to ensure skill development and content mastery.
- Interventions for core academics, homework completion, organization, and behavior through a school-wide, small-group advisory system.
- A simple uniform that supports respect for self and others and diminishes social stress.

## Our Partners

Columbus Collegiate Academy also partners with a variety of organizations to ensure students have access to a world-class, well-rounded education. A sample of partner organizations and their role at CCA are listed below:

- 1girl - Provides girls' empowerment training for students during after-school programming
- My Brother's Keeper - Provides mentorship to male students throughout the year in partnership with St. Charles Preparatory School high school students.
- ProMusica Chamber Orchestra - Two classes of violin are offered to 30 scholars through the ProMusica partnership. ProMusica provides the violin teacher and instruments.
- YMCA Camp Willson - 7th and 8th grade students spend a day at Camp Willson in the spring for team and relationship-building activities.
